**ABOUT THE SEMINAR**

Viewed differently, the quality of research is also relative to the paradigm of research adhered to namely, positivistic, interpretive or critical. The role of ICT for quality of research in education has to be examined within the connotative framework of the quality of research outlined above. The deliberations in the seminar can therefore be centered around the following subthemes.

**Papers:** Last date for receiving the full paper is 15 March, 2013. Papers should be typed in double space in MS word format in Times New Roman fonts with font size of 12 for English & Kruti dev 010 fonts with font size of 14 in case of Hindi papers. The full papers should be sent in both hard and a soft copy.

Paper will be examined by the scrutiny committee whose decision will be final. Author/ one of the authors will be intimated about the decision on their papers via e-mail only.
